Commenting on the title of the official message, Haji Feisal stated that it reflects dynamism and invites all parties to move forward together and work together to achieve the goals together.


The message provides information about the country's football to FIFA counterparts by updating the latest and most recent developments in Brunei football.

The Extraordinary FABD Congress is an important moment for FABD and the entire football community of Brunei Darussalam.

The Presidential Elections for the 2024-2028 session was successfully held on December 16, 2023, witnessing the appointment of the President, Vice President, and Excomembers, but, significant challenges still exist in obtaining funding from FIFA.

However, with the unanimous approval of the updated 2022 accounts by the New FABD members eligible to vote, there is optimism about this next step. These accounts have been meticulously presented to FABD's principal auditor, Deloitte and Touche in Singapore, for verification. This will pave the way for further submission to the AFC. The release of FIFA funding depends on this crucial step.

FABD expresses gratitude to AFC and FIFA for their promises of financial support, but it must be understood that this process may take time to fully materialize. In the meantime.

FABD remains committed to upholding the principles of Efficiency, Trustworthiness, and Honesty (CAB) – striving to avoid further financial complications.

FABD President, Feisal Eusoff outlined these matters at the 2024 Extraordinary FABD Congress held at Hotel Mulia, Berakas on February 17, 2024.

The congress was attended by representatives from District Football Associations, representatives from football and futsal clubs. Meanwhile, AFC Officials, Siti Zuraina and Nhodkeo Phawadee, and AFF General Secretary, Winston Lee also attended to witness the congress conducted in accordance with the FABD Statutes.

The Football Association of Brunei Darussalam (FABD) continues to intensify its efforts and improve its endeavours to realize its desire to transform the football landscape in the country of Brunei Darussalam.

These efforts include seeking support and concerted cooperation from all sectors concerned with the association.

In this regard, the Minister of Education (MOE), the Honourable Datin Seri Setia Dr. Hajah Romaizah binti Haji Md Salleh, received a courtesy visit from the President of FABD, Feisal Eusoff, along with his entourage at the Ministry on February 21st.

The President of FABD said that cooperation with the Ministry of Education is crucial in assisting FABD to move forward, especially in terms of human resource support and permission to use facilities such as fields and halls for football and Futsal training and matches.

"If granted permission, FABD intends to cooperate in maintaining the fields used by football clubs using FABD's allocation," he explained.

Meanwhile, FABD seeks cooperation from the ministry to obtain data on male students aged between 9 and 12 years who are economically disadvantaged to be financially supported by FABD to participate in the 'Grassroots' football program.

FABD also requested permission for school leave flexibility for students aged 20 years and below who are selected to represent the national squad.

BERAKAS, February 26, 2024 - The Ministry of Education through the Physical Education and Recreation Division, Curriculum Development Department in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports, Brunei Darussalam and the Brunei Darussalam Football Association (FABD) jointly held the Official Opening Ceremony of the Brunei Darussalam Schools Football League Championship (BDSFL) 2024 for students from secondary schools, colleges, and sixth form centers under the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Religious Affairs.

The championship takes place every Monday and Wednesday starting from February 26, 2024, until June 5, 2024, at two locations, namely the FABD Field and the Tutong Sports Complex Field.

The President of FABD, Feisal Eusoff, led the delegation, which was also attended by the Deputy President of FABD, Haji Mahrub bin Haji Murni.






Also present at the event were honourary members of FABD, FABD executive committee members, FABD staff, and representatives from football clubs in the country.
