To achieve great results, we must first become a solid TEAM BRUNEI.

I firmly believe in TEAMWORK:

TOGETHER EVERYONE ACHIEVES MORE

Nobody has all the attributes and skills to move Brunei Football Forward. But, let's not forget - what we lack, others may possess. So, when we put everyone together, we become very strong. As long as we stick together, I trust FABD will become similarly strong moving forward.

We, unfortunately, lost the momentum in 2012. We should have continued our training back then. We could have perhaps even captured a SEA Games medal. Sadly, the team was allowed to slowly disintegrate. That is water under the bridge by now.

However, today, we have the opportunity to build an even better team, and we will not squander this golden opportunity for Brunei Football to rise again.

Towards A New Era For Brunei Football

In reorganizing, restructuring, and reorientating the direction of Brunei Football, winning the once in four years presidential elections, was just the first baby step forward. Brunei football had been, as I said earlier, spiraling all the way down to a FIFA ranking of 194 in the world (as of January 2024). As FIFA has 211 member associations, almost the whole world is passing us by! Everyone knows FABD must be thoroughly cleaned up and revitalised. We must rise from the very bottom of FIFA!

It is certainly a big ASK to clean up the erstwhile malpractices - power abuse and to rejuvenate our football fortunes.

To save Brunei Football, my Exco and I, truly have our work cut out for us. After all, our expressed mission and vision is: TO SLOWLY, BUT SURELY, MOVE BRUNEI FOOTBALL FORWARD, AGAIN.

We must do this together. Everything else, is secondary.

Here is what FABD has been busy within the first month. There is, admittedly, little news for the media, but, that does not mean that we have all been just twiddling our thumbs, and not performing our duties.

In fact, we wasted no time in implementing our Mission and Vision: **Brunei Football Moving Forward.**

I will try to keep everyone posted as we go along.

Key highlights of this transformative period, beginning with my election on 16th December 2023, are as follows:

My Manifesto and Priority Four Focus Areas

In fact, my short impromptu immediate post-election speech had already set the tone moving forward. The new FABD's no and completely transparent secrets administration policy with a very strong integration of Islamic Religious Values with our nation's Melayu, Islam, Beraja (MIB) philosophy, as well as my own 'Cekap, Amanah, Bersih (CAB)' dictum, form the key codes of good governance in and Brunei Football Moving Forward. I also emphasised four critical focus areas for the future - 1. Grassroots Development, 2. Youth Development, 3. Improving the local Football Clubs, and 4. Producing better National Teams. These are the key priorities of my administration. They are all being put into place, even as I speak.

At this juncture, let me thank you all FIFA/AFC/AFF/FABD-authorised Brunei Football Delegates who gave me a near-unanimous vote of confidence during the elections. Please assist the new FABD to become better today, than yesterday, and better tomorrow, than today. Similarly, I would like all our football teams to employ this simple strategy - to continuously improve by small cumulative increments.

FIFA World Football Summit 2023 and FABD's External Collaborations

Despite a disrupted Umrah (Islamic pilgrimage), I (at the invitation of FIFA) flew to Jeddah for the FIFA World Football Summit 2023 on 21st December 2023, where pivotal global football policies were rolled out for 2024.

To cut the long story short, the FIFA President, Mr Gianni Infantino, pledged his full support for the new FABD Administration, and Brunei's football aspirations (as per my manifesto).

Notably, discussions with Shaikh Salman bin Ebrahim Al Khalifa, the AFC similar President. also yielded commitments and assurances, thereby solidifying external support for my manifesto, and for FABD Moving Forward.

Seeking Financial Support, and AFC Collaboration

En route back to Brunei, I made a strategic stopover at Kuala Lumpur to engage in further friendly discussion with Yang Bahagia Datuk Seri Windsor John, AFC General Secretary - focused on securing financial backing to rebuild Brunei football's still gloomy future. Datuk Windsor's confidence in the new FABD President's manifesto, and his promise of full support, marked a significant step forward as FABD steps boldly into a still uncertain future.

A strategic meeting with Encik Nokman Bin Mustaffa, the General Secretary of the Kuala Lumpur Football Association (KLFA) was also held. He reassured me of the possibilities of KLFA working with FABD in exchanging resources resulting in the strong support and best wishes moving forward for FABD, in the Spirit of ASEAN.

Strategic Exco Meetings and First Few Weeks in Office

My virtual attendance at the first Executive Committee (Exco) meeting addressed pressing issues like our financial situation and the importance of youth competitions. Upon officially assuming office. particularly emphasised my attention to details - stressing the importance of cleanliness and for even the FABD cleaners, to accordingly, continuously project a positive public image for the consistent association with our aspirations. "Everyone has an important role to play MOVING BRUNEI FOOTBALL FORWARD." It is not just FABD's job, alone. It is also every Brunei football enthusiast's responsibility.

Engaging External Stakeholders

I also seized the opportunity to engage with Kuwait's U-23 team, demonstrating my sincere commitment to fostering international partnerships for Brunei's football development.

The U-23 story was an example of FABD's resolve and determination to plan for the future. Our national teams must always be alert and prepared.

We received an email from the Football Association of Thailand inviting us to play a friendly game against Kuwait U-23 (received at the end of December 2023) to be played in the final few days of January 2024.

Though it was a very tight timeline,

I nevertheless grabbed the opportunity for our boys to play against a vastly superior Kuwait team (138 in FIFA ranking compared to Brunei's current 194). I believe that there is just so much for Brunei players to learn from this proposed match!

BUT, FABD needed to find the best possible way to send our U-23 team over to Thailand (from Brunei Darussalam) - chief among which, is the financial consideration. This is because the FIFA/AFC funds for 2024 have not arrived yet. We basically inherited an empty shell!

Nevertheless, recognising that this was a golden opportunity for Brunei to analyse our strengths and weaknesses (and to set this team up for future competitions) continuous training is, therefore, critical.

To manage this matter, we had a meeting with our AFC 'A' licensed coaches who all agree that we (FABD) must feel pleased and gratified to be even invited. It was just too oppurtunity to miss.

However, due to the Kuwait U-23 team's subsequent sudden pulling out at the last minute, the highly anticipated Brunei vs Kuwait friendly did not materialise.

Nonetheless, it was decided that for the sake of continuity, the team training must proceed as planned - even though funding is still uncertain. This is where the sincerity of our coaches and players come into play.

Brunei Football Moving Forward

I have also been busy talking to local personalities like Brunei football legend, Dato Paduka Seri Haji Morni bin Haji Muhammad. an ex-Brunei National Player, who shared his candid opinion with us:

He trusts that his experience in the system he went through during his time, and how we can perhaps similarly implement and use it as well - mixing and blending the old (the tried, tested, and the trusted) with the new methods today, will perhaps present FABD with the best way forward.

also shared Dato his insights rebuilding school football through youth initiatives. This opinion and others too, will be at the back of our minds, moving forward.

Brainstorming for Progress

In a collaborative effort, the elected Deputy President, Haji Mahrub bin Haji Murni, and the President, along with the General Acting Secretary. Zaeem orchestrated Omarali, some brainstorming sessions with key FABD staff and stakeholders.



Qatar became the global football community's focal point when they hosted the Asian Cup 2024. The 18th edition witnessed Asia's top 24 teams competing for the coveted Asian Cup 2024 through 51 matches across 9 stadiums in Qatar.

Feisal Eusoff, President of the Brunei Darussalam Football Association (FABD), was among the invited guests at the official opening ceremony held at Lusail Stadium in Qatar on January 12, 2024.

THE FIRST MEETING OF FABD WITH **FOOTBALL CLUBS**

Football club managers under the umbrella of the Football Association of Brunei Darussalam (FABD) gathered for the first time to sit together with the President and Executive Committee of FABD to discuss the current situation and developments of FABD since their appointment for the 2024-2028 session.
